FOR WHOM IS THE COURSE INTENDED? There is increasing interest in the spiritual journey and how it relates to living faithfully in today's world. This speaks of a need for trained spiritual directors. This programme aims to deepen and extend the training given in the 'Training in Spiritual Conversation' course (formerly Training in Faith Accompaniment).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must have satisfactorily completed Training in Spiritual Conversation or equivalent. Consideration will be given to applicants with comparable experience which includes knowledge of Ignatian spirituality and some practice in Ignatian discernment. Applicants are expected to have experience of regular spiritual direction and of individually guided retreats.

PRACTICE IN SPIRITUAL DIRECTION: Participants are expected to be developing a practice in spiritual direction. This means accompanying at least 2 people regularly, preferably 3, in their spiritual journey, so as to be able to apply course learning, and to reflect about practice in the supervision group which forms part of the training.

METHOD: The programme is experience-based and uses small groups, role plays, case studies, triad practice, personal reflection, supervision, input and discussion as methods of learning. There is one written assignment per module.
